

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY AND RESCUE GRANT BUDGETS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLAIMING POLICE SALARIES AND EMPLOYER PAYROLL CONTRIBUTIONS

**WHEREAS,** the American Rescue Plan Act "ARPA" became law on March 11, 2021, and provides fiscal relief funds to state and local governments and other program areas aimed at mitigating the continuing effects of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, ARPA provides support to local governments in responding to the impact of COVID-19 and in their efforts to contain COVID-19 and prescribes the uses of funding including one to address lost revenue for cities and towns; and

**WHEREAS**, the Unites States Department of Treasury (hereinafter Treasury), has issued guidance and a Final Rule (hereinafter FR) regarding the use of ARPA funds; and

WHEREAS, the FR permits cities and towns to apply ARPA grant fund up to \$10,000,000 or the total amount of the city's ARPA grant award, whichever is less, for governmental services and it expressly included "the provision of police and other public safety services" in a list of non-exclusive enumerated uses; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Brookland City Council, that:

- **Section 1.** The City of Brookland hereby appropriates from the City's portion of the American Rescue Plan Act Grant a total amount of \$328,237.17 to claim police salary and employer payroll contribution expenses from the date of April 1, 2022, to October 31, 2022.
- Section 2. The City Council directs the Office Manager to move the expenditures of police and applicable employer contributions from the city budget to Rescue Grant and pay the city general fund for the expenses from the Rescue Grant. The City's 2022 budget is hereby amended by decreasing the expenditures in the amount of \$328,237.17, and the 2022 grant budget is hereby amended by increasing the budget in the amount of \$328,237.17 for the police expenses for the time period of April 1, 2022, to October 31, 2022.

## **Section 3.** On the mandatory Annual Report, these police expenses shall be reported under the expenditure Category (EC) number 7.1 entitled Revenue Replacement.
