New Business:

1. Brookland Parks Committee Update:

David Loggins, Parks Committee Chairman was present to give the council an update. Loggins informed the council that chat has been laid on the sportsplex for the road leading to the concession stand area. Loggins stated that the plan is to complete both smaller city parks first and then use the remaining funds to complete as much of the sportsplex as possible. Work is progressing on the smaller parks. Councilman David Gambill asked about whether or not playground equipment had been purchased for the parks and Loggins informed him that it has not yet been ordered. They are hoping to get some further bids for equipment at a cheaper price.

2. Establish a separate Utility Fund bank account for Act 605 Reserve Funds:

Mayor Jones informed the council that the auditor advised that the city needs to open a separate bank account for the reserve funds. The account has to hold 5% of the city's annual budget

To: Approve establishing a utility fund bank account for Act 605 Reserve funds.

Discussion: Councilman Wilson Shipman asked if it would be an interest-bearing account. Jones informed him that it would. Councilman David Gambill asked if that account had to hold 5% of the annual budget and Jones informed him that was the correct amount. Gambill also asked Jones about the city's ability to access the funds if needed. Jones responded that the city would have access to the money if needed for a breakdown, failure, or improvements, if needed.

3. Transfer remaining ARPA fund balance to General Fund and close account:

Mayor Jones informed the council that the city needs to close the ARPA fund account, which currently has a balance of around \$2,700.00, and move the funds into the General Fund.

4. Discuss Jamar Technologies Traffic Counter/Speed/Cars:

Councilman David Gambill asked about the placement of the machines and Jones responded that the police department would like for both machines to float to different spots around the city, as needed.

8. West Matthews Street - extension to HWY 49N - update:

Mayor Jones updated the council on the status of this project. Jones informed the council that the city is still waiting for an update from the gas company regarding the gas line that runs through the property and it's location under the proposed right of way. Jones said the city needs information from the gas company on what the possibilities are to work around the gas line. Jones also stated that work will begin soon to clean out a ditch that will enable excess water to flow as needed. Jones said he will keep the council updated as information becomes available.

9. West School Street turn lane; ARDOT agreement:

Mayor Jones gave an update regarding the addition of a W. School Street turn lane. Jones said the city is still waiting to find out if their grant has been accepted in order to proceed with this project. Jones said he will keep the council updated as soon as he receives information.

10. Library request for expansion:

Mayor Jones asked the council if they had any questions or ideas to help with the library expansion. Since nothing was discussed, the council decided to table this item for now.

11. Matt Duryea with Arrowhead Fiber Optic – wants to run fiber optic in Brookland:

No one was present to speak on this item. The council decided to table this item for now.

12. Planning Charette update:

Mayor Jones informed the council that he had spoken with James Walden about the Planning Charette and Walden was still working on putting together some information that could be shared at a later date.
