4. ARDOT – TAP HWY 49B Sidewalks Phase 3 - \$163,000 in Federal Funding:

Mayor Jones read aloud a letter from ARDOT regarding this award and what it includes. The monies will be used to continue building sidewalks from Brookland School Administration office located on the corner of Smith Street south to Stevens Street.

5. Legacy Landfill – Increasing tipping fees \$1.25 per ton, effective 3/1/24; new rate is \$43.75 per ton. Mayor Jones informed the council that Legacy Landfill will be increasing their tipping fees by \$1.25 per ton beginning March 1, 2024, making the new rate \$43.75 per ton.
