A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF CITY OF BROOKLAND TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland understands Federal-aid Transportation Alternatives Program Funds are available at 80% federal participation and 20% local match to develop the Highway 49B Sidewalks (Ph. IV), and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland understands that Federal-aid Funds are available for this project on a reimbursable basis, requiring work to be accomplished and proof of payment prior to actual monetary reimbursement, and

WHEREAS, this project, using federal funding, will be open and available for use by the general public and maintained by the applicant for the life of the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BROOKLAND CITY COUNCIL THAT:

SECTION I: The City of Brookland will participate in accordance with its designated responsibility, including maintenance of this project.

SECTION II: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the construction of the above-stated project.

SECTION III: The Brookland City Council pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the Arkansas Department of Transportation to initiate action to implement this project.
