

ORDINANCE NO. 1980-2

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN OF BROOKLAND OF CRAIGHEAD COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SUBORDINATE SERVICE DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF FIRE PROTECTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARKANSAS STATUTE 17-4109, and that;

Article 1. The Town of Brookland shall pay to the BROOKLAND FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ENACTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARKANSAS STATUTE 17-4109 25 percent of the general revenue Fund per annum.

Article 2. The Town of Brookland shall lease to the BROOKLAND FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT any and all equipment (which is enumerated in an attachment to this agreement) owned by the town for a period not less than ten years for a sum of 1 dollar (s) per year. Should the Brookland Fire protection District dissolve then any and all equipment previously owned and leased would become property of the town of Brookland. *now back*

Article 3. Under this agreement the Fire Protection for the Town of Brookland under this proposed district will be the same as the portion of the district lying outside the city limits.

Dear Mr. Hightower,

This letter is in reference to the phone conversation that you recently had with Captain Nelms of our department. As he explained, there was a request on your records to inspect the Town of Brookland for a lower insurance rate. Since that request, our department has established a subordinate service district for fire protection. The description of this district is located on the first page of the county ordinance which is enclosed.

As you will noticed, the Town of Brookland is not included in the written description of the ordinance, but there is an agreement between the department and the Town of Brookland for their fire protection. The purpose of this arrangement is that we did not want to bind the city into a fire district forever. We feel that our town has potential to grow and we may want to go back to a city fire department in the years to come. As you will see, in our agreement we do not plan this for at least ten more years.

As a city alderman, I can assure you that Mayor Barnett and the rest of the town council are pleased with the fire district. In the years past the Town of Brookland has furnished fire protection for all of the residents inside and outside the city limits of Brookland. There was a charge of \$50.00 to persons living outside the city limits, but many times we were unable to collect the charge. We feel that with this district we can provide the adequate fire protection to all residents living in a five mile radius of Brookland.

We understand that the lowest possible rate that we can obtain in the district would be a nine rating because of the water supply. We feel that the Town of Brookland might possibly obtain a lower rate, if it is possible to inspect these areas separatly. We have enclosed the information that you requested from Captain Nelms. You should have on your files the water supply and communications that our department recently sent to your office. We are ready for the inspection as soon as your office can work us in. We hoped that we could get this by the start of the next quarter if at all possible.

If you need any more information you can contact either myself or my captain.

AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE



Article 4: The Town of Brookland hereby agrees to provide housing for any and all equipment owned or leased by the Brookland Fire Protection District. Under this agreement the Town will furnish all utilities through the date of 12-31-82.


Article 5: The Brookland Fire Protection District will pick up gas heating bills only, beginning January 1, 1983.

Article 6: Location of said housing is located on the west side of Brookland on Bemis Street.
