

## A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland, understands Federal-aid Transportation Alternatives Program Funds are available at 80% federal participation and 20% local match to develop or improve HWY 49 B Sidewalk Improvements, and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland, Arkansas understands that Federal-Aid Funds are available for this project on a reimbursable basis, requiring work to be accomplished and proof of payment prior to actual money reimbursement, and

WHEREAS this project, using federal funding, will be open and available for use by the general public and maintained by the City of Brookland.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKLAND THAT:

SECTION I. The City of Brookland will participate in accordance with its designated responsibility, including maintenance of this project.

SECTION II. The Mayor of the City of Brookland is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the construction of the above stated project.

SECTION III. The City of Brookland pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the Mayor of the City of Brookland to cooperate with the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department to initiate action to implement this project.
